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### COUNTY EXECUTIVE OVERHAULS ULSTER COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH

Kingston, NY (July 8, 2009) - As part of an ongoing initiative to make Ulster County the "Healthiest County in New York State"; and in accordance with the Ulster County Charter, County Executive Mike Hein has named members to the U.C. Board of Health. His appointments are as follows:

County Executive Hein has also added noted infectious disease specialist Dr. Marc Tack to a five year term and OB GYN, Dr. Dominique Delma to a four year term. "Adding these two extraordinary physicians clearly strengthens the Board and better serves public health interests of the people of Ulster County. As we face issues like H1N1 "swine flu", Lyme disease, pre-natal healthcare concerns and so much more, individuals like Dr. Tack and Dr. Delma will be invaluable," said the County Executive.

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Section C-42 of the Ulster County Charter outlines the process of appointing members to the Board of Health. All members were currently serving as holdovers pending appointment of the Executive. The appointments of these board members must be confirmed by the Ulster County Legislature. Varying term lengths for the Board of Health are set forth in the County Charter.

The County Executive added, "I would like to thank Mr. Steven Kelly for his service. He, as President and C.E.O. of Ellenville Regional Hospital, will continue play an integral roll in providing the highest quality healthcare throughout Ulster County. These appointments simply reflect my administrations desire for additional physician participation on the Board of Health."
