

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The New York State Division Of Homeland Security And Emergency Services To Provide For The Enhancement Of Ulster County's Digital Orthoimagery Data – Department Of Information Services

Chairman of the Environmental, Energy and Technology Committee, Carl Belfiglio, and Deputy Chairman Tracey A. Bartels offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Information Services; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) is coordinating the collection of up-to-date aerial imagery in Ulster County which was begun in the spring of 2013 as part of the Statewide Digital Orthoimagery Program; and

WHEREAS, the Statewide Digital Orthoimagery Program offers the County the ability to upgrade the County's current imagery; and

WHEREAS, the upgraded digital orthoimagery provided by DHSES will allow the County to provide enhanced public safety, environmental, and planning applications, as well as support existing geographic information system program projects; and

WHEREAS, the cost to procure the upgraded digital orthoimagery is \$113,998.97, which amount will be paid through a grant secured by the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services (DHSES #C835300, CFDA # 97.067)) and therefore no County funds will be expended; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Information Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement with DHSES for the provision of upgraded digital orthoimagery data in the amount of \$113,998.97; now, therefore, be it
