Dear Supervisor and Highway Superintendant:

Ulster County, as lead applicant, will be applying for funding this year through the Department of State's Local Government Efficiency (LGE) Program, formerly known as the Shared Municipal Services Incentive Grant Program (SMSI). The grant we are applying for is for municipalities that have received SMSI Study grants and are ready to implement a shared service initiative. This year the County is requesting LGE funding, not to exceed \$1,000,000 by LGE criteria.
